Due to the school days missed because of the flood day and Hurricane Irma, the following plan has been approved to recover the missed instructional clock hours for Fort Myers Technical College students.

- ◆ Starting on **October 2, 2017** and finishing on **March 29, 2018**, student dismissal is extended to 3:00 p.m.
- ◆ **October 16, 2017** is a school day for all students (formerly a Teacher Professional Duty Day).
- ◆ **December 22, 2017** is a school day for all students (formerly a Teacher Professional Duty Day).
